
that have been brought to my attention.



Added Loxahatchee plants in Coquina Sand landscaped areas, I.E., under trees ETC.

Roger Federer began his quest for an 18th major title & his 1st in Australia since 2010 by defeating Lu Yen Hsun from Taiwan. 3 time Australian finalist Andy Murray opened his bid for an elusive Aussie title with a win against Indian qualifier Yuki Bhambre.

2nd ranked Maria Sharapova followed up her recent title at Brisbane International with a win over Petra Martic. The women's #1 Serena Williams, who has won 5 titles at Melbourne Park, had a good start as well.

Top seeds, Djokovic & Serena Williams both had straight-set wins in their 1st round matches. Djokovic shrugged off the effects of a cold to beat #116 Aljag Bedine in his 1st Grand Slam match as a father. Serena beat #106 ranked Alison Van Uytvanski. Serena had arrived in Australia "jet-lagged" & asked for a cup of coffee after a lackluster beginning 1st set. I don't know what was in that coffee or how it was brewed but you can bet I'm switching to that brand!!! Serena not only woke up but rallied for a big win.

34 year old Venus Williams advanced to her 1st quarter-final in a major event since Wimbledon in 2010. Venus lovingly credited her sister, Serena, for her support & inspiration during the past 4 years as she battled the energy-sapping disease Sjogren's Syndrome. This, of course, being the reason for her absence in the finals of big tournaments until now. Venus said, "Definitely my sister, Serena, the ultimate champion & all my fans who have stood behind me through "thick & thin" have helped me to get here."

The women's quarterfinals included Serena Williams, Makarova, Sharapova & Halep. The men's quarterfinals included Djokovic, Wasorinkev, Ravnic & Andy Murray.

Poor Raphael Nadal was knocked out of the Australian Open in the quarterfinals by Berdych. He has only been able to play 8 matches since last June due to a severe wrist injury & an appendix operation in November.

Serena Williams literally "jumped for joy" after defeating

Maria Sharapova, giving her a "6 for 6" winning record in the Australian Open. To quote her, "I'm so honored to hold this 19th trophy. I didn't think it would happen this fast, but it feels good." Williams at 33 is the oldest winner in the Open's era, passing Chris Evert & Martina Navratilova at 18 wins. #20 is her next objective & she'll get her chance at the French Open.

Djokovic captured his 8th career major. He said, "His 1st Grand Slam title since his marriage & the birth of his son had a deeper meaning - a more intrinsic value. Getting married & becoming a father was definitely something that gave me a new energy - something that I never felt before."

## Cooking

The earliest big St. Patrick's Day parades were in New York City and in Boston in the 1700s—little surprise, given the large number of families with Irish roots in those cities. Today St. Patrick's Day festivities happen worldwide (even in Japan.)

### IRISH STEW

2 pounds lamb or beef stew meat  
5 medium onions

Chopped parsley and thyme to taste

Salt and pepper to taste

1-1/2 cups water

Trim meat and cut into fairly large pieces. Peel and slice the potatoes and onions. Put layers of potatoes, meat, onion and herbs and seasoning into a pot, finishing with a layer of potatoes. Pour the water over the meat and vegetables and bring to a boil. Simmer gently for about 2 hours or bake in a slow oven at 300 degrees. Check during cooking, adding more liquid if necessary. Makes 4 servings.

Tips: Lamb is traditionally used in Irish stew, but beef stew meat is a tasty option. Carrots and pearl barley can be added for extra color and interest. A good Irish stew should be thick and creamy, not swimming in juice.

### MUSTARD-CRUSTED CORNED BEEF

4 pounds of corned beef brisket

Cooking spray

4 slices white bread

2 teaspoons course-grind pepper

¼ cup mayonnaise

3 tablespoons prepared horseradish from a jar, drained

2 tablespoons spicy brown mustard

According to package directions cook corned beef until tender, 3-1/2 hours. Remove from pot; cook 15 minutes. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Coat shallow roasting pan with cooking spray. In food processor process bread until fine crumbs form; combine with pepper. Combine mayonnaise, horseradish and mustard. Using paper towel, pat beef dry. Spread about 1/3 mayonnaise mixture over bottom of beef; press on some of crumb mixture. Place beef with cooking spray. Bake until golden, about 10 minutes. Transfer to serving platter. Makes 12 servings.

### BEER-BRAISED CABBAGE AND CARROTS

4 slices bacon, cut crosswise into ¼" pieces

1 head green cabbage, cut into 1-1/2 wide wedges

1 onion, halved, thinly sliced, about 1 cup

3 carrots, diagonally cut into 1-1/2 pieces

1 bottle (12 ounces) beer

2 tablespoons honey

2 tablespoons vinegar, preferably

apple cider

1 teaspoon coarsely-grind pepper

In a large pot over medium-high heat cook bacon until crisp, 6-8 minutes; drain on paper towels. To fat in pot add cabbage and onion; cook stirring occasionally, 5 minutes. Stir in carrots and beer; cover. Reduce heat to low; simmer until vegetables are tender, 20 minutes. Drain. Return vegetables to pot over low heat; heat, stirring, until any liquid evaporates. Stir in honey, vinegar, salt and pepper; heat, stirring until most of liquid evaporates. Transfer to serving bowl; sprinkle with bacon. Makes 6 servings.

### SHAMROCK CUPCAKES

Cake Mix

Water, eggs and oil

1 cup butter, at room temperature

4 cups confectioners' sugar

3 tablespoons milk

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1/8 teaspoon green

concentrated food coloring, such as Wilton's Kelly green

24 leaf-shaped spearmint gumdrops

Green edible glitter, nonpareils and dragees, optional

1 small tube green decorating gel

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Line 24 muffin cups with liners. Prepare cake mix with water, eggs and oil according to package directions. Divide batter among liners. Bake 20 minutes or until toothpick inserted into centers comes out clean. Cool 10

minutes. Transfer from pans to racks; cool. On medium speed, beat butter and sugar until fluffy, about 2 minutes. Transfer half of frosting to separate bowl. Stir food coloring into one bowl of frosting. Transfer frostings to separate pastry bags fitted with star tips; pipe over cupcakes. Make shamrocks following directions, below. Decorate cupcakes with gumdrop shamrocks, and, if desired, glitter, nonpareils, dragees and gel.

Super-simple shamrocks! For shamrocks, roll out gumdrops to 1/4 thickness. Sprinkle with glitter, pressing onto gumdrops with rolling pin. Using 1-1/2 shamrock-shaped cutter, cut out shamrocks.

## MINI IRISH SODA BREADS

- 4 cups all-purpose flour
- 2/3 cup sugar
- 1 cup raisins
- 5 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 tablespoon caraway seeds
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 1-1/3 cups milk
- 2 eggs

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Coat baking sheet with cooking spray. In bowl combine first 7 ingredients; stir in milk and 1 egg until combined. On lightly floured surface knead mixture until dough forms, about

2 minutes. Divide dough into 12 pieces; shape into round loaves. Place on baking sheet. Using kitchen scissors snip tops of loaves in centers to make Xs. Lightly beat remaining egg; brush over breads. Bake 30 minutes or until golden. Makes 12 breads.

## Bridge Player's Survival Kit

### Strong jump shifts by responder

Many of my students want to jump on their first bid when responding with a good hand. Don't be in a rush if you don't know what trumps should be. As long as you make a bid that opener can't pass, you'll be able to explore for a fit while at a low level and show your strength later. Opener might have to jump shift in order to show a maximum hand, but not responder. *A new suit by an unpassed responder is forcing (unless someone at the table has bid 1NT).*

Invariably, a student will ask, "What type of hand would I need to jump shift as responder?" A jump shift by responder isn't merely a game-going

hand. It says right off the bat, "Let's talk about slam." Such hands do not come up often, but it's good to have an agreement for when they do, as in the following case.

(1) North was sure her hearts were good enough to be trump without any help from partner. She felt game was assured and a slam was quite possible! The jump shift forced the partnership to at least game.

(2) South's 2NT was natural and showed stoppers in the unbid suits. It implied less than primary heart support and was forcing because game had not yet been reached.

(3) North's 3♥ confirmed a solid heart suit. Solid means A-K-Q-J-x-x or A-K-Q-10-x-x-x at the very least.

(4) After using the Blackwood convention to check for aces and kings, South settled for a small slam, bidding 6NT because of the scoring (matchpoints). Indeed, 6NT scored 10 points more than 6♥, and North-South earned a top.

#### Strong jump shift requirements

The late Paul Soloway popularized the concept that a jump shift by responder should show one of three specific hand types:

- 1 A hand with a solid suit of its own and at least 16 total points. Responder jumps into his independent suit and bids it a second time after opener's rebid.
- 2 A hand with great trump support for opener's suit, at least 16 points and a good side suit. Responder jumps into his side suit and raises opener's suit at his next bid.
- 3 A semi-balanced hand with at least 18-19 HCP. Responder jumps into his longest side suit and rebids notrump next to show this hand.

Strong jump shifts are standard (as opposed to weak jump shifts, which are Alertable in non-competitive auctions). Be very cautious in jump-shifting as responder, as it takes up a lot of bidding space. It's time for you to leave your cowboy bidding in the past and switch to more scientific bidding. ■

#### ► Mike's Bridge Lesson *cont.*

If the diamond suit fails, try the clubs. The 3-3 split will yield a long club trick for you nearly 36% of the time.

Remember, you don't need both good things to occur. Think like this:

- I have a 36% chance that clubs will split evenly.
- Because there is a 33% chance that the ♦ Q will drop when I lead out the ace and the king, the odds are 67% that the ♦ Q will not fall.
- Combining these chances succeeds when the ♦ Q drops (33%) or when the clubs split and the ♦ Q does not come down (36% of 67% = 24%).
- Playing out the top clubs and diamonds, I will bring home nine tricks nearly 57% of the time - slightly better than the 50% finesse. ■

I am no longer your director, I really enjoyed the residents of the Towers.



## "Ask Lori"

**Helpful Tax Saving Advice and Tips from  
Broward County Property Appraiser Lori Parrish**

Dear Lori:

We are a same-sex married couple who bought a home in Broward County. Since Florida finally grants legal recognition to the rights of same-sex married couples, what steps can we take to help us enjoy the same rights and financial protections under the law?

P.K. & S.W., Fort Lauderdale, FL (via email)

On January 6, 2015, Florida began recognizing LGBT marriages performed in other jurisdictions and issuing marriage licenses for LGBT couples married in Florida. This tremendous step forward for equality allows new legal status for married LGBT couples with ownership of real property as Tenants By The Entireties (TBTE).

Tenants By The Entirety (TBTE): This applies only to married couples. This TBTE status -- which is automatic when the Grantees of a deed are identified as a married LGBT couple -- gives each spouse overlapping 100% interests in their Homestead Property Tax Exemption, full exemption coverage (when one spouse receives the Homestead Exemption), Widow/Widower, qualified Veteran's related exemptions, and rights of survivorship (inheritance) for the surviving spouse.

The creation of a tenancy by the entireties is not automatic as a result of marriage. A new deed changing the ownership type of a couple to a married couple must be recorded in Public Records. Be sure to consult with your attorney and get his/her assistance before making changes to the ownership of your property. Even if you choose not to execute a new deed amending your marital status, we recommend you provide our office with a copy of your marriage license so we may notate your marital status and extend to you all exemptions available to married couples.

It is very important both spouses with an ownership interest in the property file individually for Homestead Exemption. The Homestead Exemption and related Save-Our-Homes (SOH) protection saved the average Broward homeowner in 2014 with an assessed value of \$75,000 or higher anywhere from \$646 to \$1,114 a year in taxes. With SOH, your property's assessed value can increase by no more than 3% per year - regardless of how much it climbs in actual value. Florida law protects a legal spouse in the event their spouse dies and the title passes to the survivor.

Under Florida law, married couples are only permitted one Homestead Exemption/permanent residency based property tax exemption. Prior to January 6, 2015, LGBT couples married outside of Florida could maintain two permanent residency based property tax exemptions because their legal status was not recognized in Florida. Now, LGBT married couples (as any married couple) cannot claim more than one Florida Homestead Exemption and cannot claim a Florida Homestead Exemption if either person is claiming a permanent residency based property tax exemption anywhere in the world.

Since recognition of LGBT marriages in Florida took place after January 1, 2015, beginning with the 2016 tax year LGBT married couples will be subject to a loss of their Florida Homestead Exemption, back assessment liens, penalties, and interest, if they are found to be claiming a Florida Homestead Exemption and another permanent residency based exemption anywhere else. Florida law requires a Homestead Exemption recipient/applicant to notify the Property Appraiser of any change in circumstance which affects his/her eligibility for exemption. To avoid any of these consequences, married couples should determine which Homestead Exemption/permanent residency based exemptions to surrender and which one to keep as soon as possible then notify the Property Appraiser's Office of their decision.

We recommend you consult with your attorney to best protect your LGBT rights under Florida law. Regular physical activity can help the human body maintain, repair, and improve itself to an amazing degree. And most older people – even those with illnesses or disabilities - can take part in moderate exercise programs.

People who exercise regularly may also be less apt to suffer fractures or other accidents. Exercise must become one of those things that you do without question, like bathing or brushing your teeth.
